Dark brown to black Shiny hard body Large pincers or antlers on males, smaller on females Will fly Advice only Ladybird 3-7mm Usually bright red with 2-10 black spots (although numbers can vary), also can be black with a varying number of black spots Oval in shape Advice only Crickets 16mm long Larger than the common grasshopper
